



Half day tours run from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. February through May and September through November. And 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon June through August. You and your Moab Cyclery guide will be dropped off at the top of Shafer Trail and picked up at Lathrop Canyon on the Colorado River for a relaxing, scenic ride back to town on our large jetboat.

The Slickrock Trail

Spring, Summer and Fall - Arguably the most famous trail in the world. Steep climbs and descents on sandstone with twelve miles of spectacular views. This is a great tour for intermediate to advanced level riders. The Slickrock Trail can also be offered as a half-day option.
